## Things To Do

- The Bailey-Matthews Shell Museum and the Sanibel Historic Village are fascinating stops on the tourist trail.
- The Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation & Tarpon Bay Explorers offer programs, hands-on nature encounters and scenic island tours that will make for a memorable stay on Sanibel Island.
- Pick up some tropical gifts and mementos from one of the many island boutiques. Dig into fresh seafood at an award-winning restaurant, and then take in local entertainment at the Schoolhouse Theater.

Of course, Sanibel is surrounded by miles of gorgeous, shell-strewn beaches that promise plenty of fun-filled days of sunning, swimming and sailing.
